AT DALLAS, TEXAS:

On January 28, 1964, Mrs. MARTHA KNOWLES, Hidell Hardware Company, 4507 Travis, advised WILLIAM E. HIDEELL (deceased) was formerly connected with Hidell Hardware Company, and his wife, Mrs. WILLIAM E. HIDEELL, also known as JACKIE HIDEELL, had an interest in the company until about two years ago when her interest was purchased by KNOWLES.

WILLIAM E. HIDEELL, JR., son of WILLIAM E. HIDEELL (deceased), is an architect with offices at 3000 Turtle Creek Plaza, Dallas. WILLIAM E. HIDEELL, JR., has never been connected with Hidell Hardware Company.

According to Mrs. KNOWLES, there is no ALEX HIDEELL, JR., connected with this hardware company, and, to her knowledge, there has never been an ALEX HIDEELL in Dallas, Texas.

On January 28, 1964, WILLIAM E. HIDEELL, JR., 3000 Turtle Creek Plaza, furnished the following information concerning the HIDEELL family:

His father, WILLIAM E. HIDEELL, SR., (deceased) had three brothers, HENRY ROBINSON HIDEELL, CHARLES MAXWELL HIDEELL and ALEX HIDEELL. The family name was originally HEIDELBERG but was changed to HIDEELL.

WILLIAM E. HIDEELL, JR., age 42, was born in Dallas, Texas, and has lived his entire life in Dallas, with the exception of a short time as a small boy in Fort Worth, Texas. His uncle, ALEX HIDEELL, oldest of the four HIDEELL brothers, has never been in Dallas, Texas, to his knowledge, and it is his recollection that the family lost touch with ALEX HIDEELL approximately thirty years ago, at which time he was reportedly on the West Coast and had some connection with the yacht business.

WILLIAM HIDEELL, JR., does not know if his uncle, ALEX HIDEELL, had any children, and he has never known of an ALEX HIDEELL, JR.
