Eisenhower called and related that his friend, Fred Friendly of CBS, had told the General this morning that he, Friendly, had some evidence that a campaign to undermine the FBI and me is forming. Friendly asked General Eisenhower if he thought I would see Friendly in order to set the record straight both for the FBI and for my own part.

I told General Eisenhower I would be glad to see Friendly and learn what he has in mind. General Eisenhower stated he would have Friendly call me to make arrangements for the interview.
