SUBJECT:

INTERNAL SECURITY - RUSSIA

Reference is made to United Fress International release of 11/22/60 which stated in part that this year Oswald applied for another passport. He told the State Department he wanted to visit England, France, Germany, Holland, Finland, Italy, Poland, and the Soviet Union. He said he planned to make the trip between October, 1963, and December or January, 1964. The passport was issued at New Orleans on June 25, 1965. It is not clear, however, if Oswald ever repaid for his passage back to the United States or his first trip. If he did not, a new passport should not have been issued.

A review of the records of the Passport Office, Department of State by the Washington Field Office on 11/22/65 disclosed that Oswald was last issued Passport D-092526 at New Orleans, Louisiana on 6/25/63 for proposed travel as set out above. The passport was good for travel to all countries except Albania, Cuba, and those portions of China, Korea, and Vietnam under communist control.

of State on 11/22/65 disclosed a copy of a promissory statement signed by Oswalo on 6/1/62 in Moscow. This statement outlined the total obligation for transporting Oswald and his family back to the U.S. amounting to \$455.71.2 Oswald agreed to repay this sum with the understanding that he would not be furnished a passport for foreign travel until his obligation to reimburse the Treasurer of the United States was liquidated. Oswald's loan record account discloses that the obligation was liquidated in several payments, the final payment on 7/7/63, at which time his residence was listed as Post Office Box 2915, Dallas, Texas.
