5. 2:00 p.m. Pauline Frederick from the United Nations reports this is a Memorial Session in honor of John F. Kennedy. All Assembly business suspended. President Johnson began his first day of work with a meeting with Soviet Deputy Mike Yan and report is that all ties will remain the same. Three new bills were introduced since the president's assassination.
 - a. Legislation introduced one bill to the effect that when an attack is made on the President of the United States, that it is made a Federal Offense instead of just the state where it occurs.
 - b. A second law prohibiting the sale of guns by mail.
 - c. Introduction of 1,000 College Scholarships to be given each year in honor of the late President Kennedy.
 - d. Also that the name of the Peace Corps be changed to the Kennedy Corps.Business also to the effect that the late president be awarded a Congressional Medal of Honor and that a moratorium on political speeches be in effect until the end of the year in order to give the new President any and all time available.
6. Sheriff Bill Decker of Dallas has taken issue with foreign reports that say it would be impossible for anyone to fire three shots as fast as the 20 seconds it took to shoot the President twice and the Governor once. As no autopsy was being performed on the President it does not seem conclusive that he was hit by two bullets.

8. Announcement that President Johnson addresses joint sessions of Congress tomorrow, 27 Nov.
9. Dave Danicic reporting for WBAP--Murder charges have been filed against Ruby and his trial is set for 9 December 63 in Judge Joe Irwin's court. D.A. will ask for the death penalty. One of his attorneys, Tom Howard indicates part of his defense will prove that he is a highly emotional man. Was extremely upset at the blood on Jackie Kennedy's suit after President was shot.
