1. Mrs. Connally, the Governor's wife, conveyed to the world his deep sorrow at the tragedy which occurred in Dallas. He asks that all Texans observe Monday as a day of mourning for the late President. Mrs. Connally thanks everyone for flowers but requests that those wishing to send other flowers contribute to the fund for officer Tippett instead. The Governor is out of danger and in good spirits. Remarks are made of that a wonderful tour it had started out to be and of the great feeling for the President Dallas showed until the fatal shooting.
2. Lee H. Oswald has just been shot in the stomach as he was being moved from Dallas police Station. A man was seen to do it but not yet apprehended.
3. Reported that the man ran up to Oswald as he was being led to the outside, put a pistol in his stomach and shot.
4. The area was immediately blocked off and warned reporters not to come any closer.
5. The man who shot Oswald was described as about 5'6" tall, wearing a dark suit and hat. No report on Oswald's condition.
6. The suspect was apparently posing as a reporter.
7. Oswald is being removed, presumably to Parkland hospital. Everyone is still being held in the basement of the City Jail.
8. Oswald is reported to be alive and has been placed on a pacemaker.
9. Description of the shooting of Oswald. Assassin identified as Jack Ruby.
10. Believed that Ruby would have shot again if he had the opportunity. Report that Oswald died at 1:07p.m.
11. The man arrested will be charged with murder. Everything is asked to be recorded and have a record kept.
12. Ruby has been apprehended and a murder charge will be filed.
13. There is much discussion on where Ruby was and how he managed to get in and shoot. Police seem convinced that he was in this killing by himself.
14. Oswald said nothing before he died. He was unconscious all the time. He was handcuffed at the time he was shot. Police are still seeking evidence.

15. Authorities know of no one else involved in the shooting of Oswald. Suspect has been charged with murder and there are no more suspects.
16. They have been asked if there was a call or warning that Oswald might be shot, Police Chief says he doesn't know of any.
17. Ruby seems willing to talk and answer any questions and if he doesn't have them he just says he doesn't know.
18. There is speculation as to trial.
19. Question about jurors and do they think they can find any unbiased ones?
20. Curry feels like they have a solid case. Anticipate more evidence in the next few days.
21. A talk with Ruby's attorney. No statement made as yet by Ruby. A formal charge will be made in the next few days.
22. Ralph Paul, Ruby's business partner is interviewed. He said he believed that Ruby had been married before.
23. An interview with Mrs. J.D. Tippett from her home. Mrs. Tippett makes statement and she told of the Kennedy family contacting her and President Johnson calling.
