WILLIAM J. WALDMAN, Vice President, Klein's Sporting Goods, Inc., 4540 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, advised that the Italian carbine 6.5 with V4X scope, per his records, was shipped to Dallas, Texas on March 20, 1963 by parcel post not broken down with the bolt and scope intact. The scope would have been wrapped in corrugated paper and then brown wrapping paper or newspaper would be used in wrapping to prevent shifting within the carton. It would have been shipped in a cardboard carton approximately 5' long marked "Fragile Handle With Care No. 48" made by Rudd Container Corporation, Chicago. He furnished uninitialed 6 samples of brown wrapping paper, 5 samples of paper gunned tapes, 1 sample of corrugated paper and 1 sample cardboard carton.
