

## FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date 11/27/63

A telephone call was received at the Dayton Resident Agency, FBI, at 12:11 P.M., from an individual who stated that he was DUANE CREVISTON, 6918 Rushleigh Road, Dayton, Ohio. He advised he was the same party who had telephonically contacted this Resident Agency on the previous day and furnished the information concerning the advertisement appearing in "The American Rifleman" magazine.

Mr. CREVISTON advised that the reason for his call on this date was to suggest the possibility of checking to see if the rifle used in the assassination of President KENNEDY had been "zeroed in" near Dallas and also the possibility of checking to see if reloaded ammunition had been used, as he felt both these things, if established, would show pre-meditation.

Mr. CREVISTON's voice was recognized as being identical to the party who had called on the previous day.
