The Committee was forced to close its office shortly after I last saw you. I am sorry I've been late in relating the neo-Sauvage statement regarding the Walker shooting, but the article seems to have been lost in the confusion of transporting our files from the office to storage.

However, the article I refer to appeared in "Le Figaro Littéraire" week of Dec 12-18, 1963 of which I have a loose translation. It states the shot missed Walker by ten meters. This is over 30 feet, marksmanship so poor that it is hard to believe even of a spastic.
