

Telephone conversation with Tink Thompson, Thursday night 6/6/68 about 7:30 p.m.

Mark Lane on Philadelphia TV <sup>KYW</sup> that morning, CONTACT programme, said that within the last few weeks emissaries from RFK came to Garrison, to inform him that RFK was sympathetic to his investigation, did not accept the WR either, but could not act now, because he was a candidate and he was afraid ("There are guns between him and the White House")...If elected, he would reopen the case, arrests and prosecutions would follow.
