Blast Book On Kennedy Assassin

Latest effort to undermine the basic conclusion of the Warren Commission — namely, that the self-styled Marxist Lee Harvey Oswald was the assassin of President Kennedy—is in the form of a book written by Mark Lane, a left-wing New York attorney.

Thirty thousand copies of the book, "Rush to Judgment," are being published. A documentary film, also based on the book, is scheduled for release in September.

Fortunately, however, a noted law professor at Northwestern University has prepared an analysis of the Lane book. Jon Waltz, who also co-authored "The Trial of Jack Ruby," has read the Report of the Commission, the 26 volumes of testimony upon which it was based, and material made available at the National Archives. He says: "Lane's fevered arguments have no semblance of logic or even of organization. He presents a phantasmagoric hodgepodge of unrelated and often wholly irrelevant second-guessing."
