Your proposal to publish a detailed and comprehensive subject index to the Warren Report and the volumes of Hearings and Exhibits on President Kennedy's assassination is an interesting one. I have noted that the index to the Warren Report is quite inadequate.

It seems to us that the compilation you propose would be a useful publication, but I am sorry to say that we do not feel it an appropriate one for our forthcoming lists. We would like to suggest that you talk to the reference librarians at the New York Public Library and consult, perhaps, the office of the American Historical Association in order to obtain recommendations about the best way to go about publication. One of our editors here has suggested that the scope of your project would make it suitable for computer processing.
