Under date of January 13, 1964, the Seattle Office advised that NEVIN DENNIS TESSEM, 23814 84th West, Edmonds, Washington, had advised on January 9, 1964 that he served in the U. S. Marine Corps, Squadron IX, at Santa Ana, California, during 1959. While stationed at this base, he resided in a six-man quonset hut for several weeks with DONALD OSBOURNE (believed identical to DONALD MACK OSBORNE), BOB ALLEN, and three other Marines he could not recall. TESSEM advised he did not recall JIM HARVEY OSWALD as one of the three other Marines living in this hut. He stated he did not recall ever meeting OSWALD and was sure he would remember such a meeting in light of recent events.
