I HOPE YOU ARE WELL. I DO NOT MEAN TO INTRUDE UPON YOUR PRIVACY, BUT I THOUGHT YOU WOULD WANT COPIES OF THE FOLLOWING LETTERS I RECEIVED FROM ROGER CRAIG FROM FEBRUARY TO MAY OF THIS YEAR. THERE IS STILL SOME QUESTION AS TO WHETHER HIS DEATH WAS A SUICIDE OR NOT. I HAVE NO OPINION. EITHER ALTERNATIVE IS POSSIBLE. I AM SENDING THESE LETTERS BECAUSE THEY SUPPORT MANY CONTENTIONS OF YOUR OWN RESEARCH, ESPECIALLY THE MAUSER INFORMATION. I KNOW YOU ARE RELUCTANT TO CORRESPOND BUT I WOULD APPRECIATE JUST A NOTE VERIFYING THAT YOU RECEIVED THE COPIES.

IF THERE IS ANYONE YOU WOULD LIKE ME TO SEND COPIES TO, LET ME KNOW AND I WILL BE GLAD TO OBLIGE. CRAIG CALLED ME FROM DALLAS ON MAY 5, 1975. HE WAS FOUND DEAD TEN DAYS LATER. I AM IN TOUCH WITH MANY RESEARCHERS AND I ONLY HOPE THAT MY CORRESPONDENCE WITH ROGER CRAIG WAS NOT IN ANY ^{WAY} RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS DEATH.
