EMMETT HOBSON, Burton Dixie Corporation, 817 Corinth, Dallas, Texas, was interviewed and advised that he recalled interviewing four applicants for a job as clock-trainee during the period October 4 - 10, 1963. He said those applicants came to him from the Texas Employment Commission, and he had them execute application forms and eliminated all but one because of lack of experience, poor work record, inability to write and general unfitness for the job he had available. He said that all applications were destroyed when the position was filled, and he had no independent recollection of any particular information that LEE OSWALD had put on his application form, and he was unable to recall any background information concerning OSWALD from memory.
