Mrs. SIDNEY RICHEY, owner, Commercial Employment Agency, Fort Worth National Bank Building, was interviewed based on receiving information that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had placed an application with her agency one or two years ago for a sheet metal job in Fort Worth.

Mrs. RICHEY stated that her records reflected an application card for LEE H. OSWALD, 7313 Davenport Street, Fort Worth, telephone PE 2-3245, and dated June 26, 1962.

Mrs. RICHEY stated that she recalled OSWALD coming in to the employment agency and that she herself had interviewed him. She stated that he appeared to be a quiet young man and was reluctant at first to give any information concerning where he had been employed previously doing sheet metal work. She stated that on further questioning of OSWALD he stated that he had done sheet metal work abroad, and when she finally pinned him down he stated that he had been in Russia and had returned to the United States in 1962. She said that he told her he had worked in a sheet metal factory in Moscow.

Mrs. RICHEY furnished the application, which she stated was signed by OSWALD and which she witnessed on June 26, 1962. She stated that this is the only record that she has concerning OSWALD being in her employment agency. She added that she did not get OSWALD a job and did not have any further contact with him after the initial meeting.
