Mr. L. M. MC CRACKEN, 3830 West 6th Street, advised that the mother of LEE HARVEY OSWALD lived in an apartment at 3830 West 6th approximately six years ago. At that time, LEE HARVEY OSWALD was in the U. S. Marine Corps. He came home on leave on one or two occasions and stayed around the house for about two weeks on each trip. LEE OSWALD did not have any friends and very seldom ever left the house. He spent nearly all his time reading in the apartment of his mother. MC CRACKEN never saw this boy with any friends and did not know of any associates he might have. He stated that he had not been around the OSWALD family since they moved from this address approximately six years ago. He advised at that time the mother was employed in some capacity for CLYDE CAMPBELL Men's Store in Fort Worth.
