A Baby Boy For Marina

RICHARDSON, Tex. (AP) — Marina Oswald Porter, widow of the man accused by the Warren Commission of assassinating President John F. Kennedy, has given birth to a boy, according to the Dallas Morning News.

Officials at Richardson General Hospital and Mrs. Porter's mother-in-law would neither confirm nor deny the report.

The newspaper said the 6-pound, 12-ounce boy was born Sunday and was named Mark Wayne Porter.

Mrs. Porter, 24, married Kenneth J. Porter, 28, a Dallas area electronics firm employe, June 1, 1965, about 18 months after her first husband, Lee Harvey Oswald, was shot and killed by Dallas night club operator Jack Ruby. She and Oswald had two children, June, 5, and Rachel, 3.
