Tom MULLINS, Manager of the Good Luck Oil Company (Gloco) Service Station, 1518 North Sango, Oak Cliff, Dallas, advised he has been personally acquainted with JACK RUBY, who was an occasional customer in his service station. However, he stated he had never known LEE HARVEY OSWALD although publicity following the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY at Dallas on November 22, 1963, indicated that both JACK RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD had resided in an area not too distant from the location of the station.

He said he had no recollection of waiting on a Mr. WILLIE E. WINTERS, of Round Lake, Minnesota, on the Monday before Christmas 1963 at 10:00 AM. He determined that two employees, one J. H. LEWIS, age 32, 5 feet, 2 inches, and one JAMES SYLTON, age 42, 6 feet, 1 inch, were on duty at 10:00 AM on December 22, 1963.

Mr. MULLINS said that he knew of no association or business relationship or other connection between LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY, and he had never been a customer or patron of the Carousel Club or Vegas Club, Dallas, Texas, when they were operated by RUBY.
