Mr. J. S. LEWIS, 602 Naches, Dallas, advised that he was employed by the Good Luck Oil Company (d/b/a) Service Station at 1502 North Zang on December 22, 1963. He said that he knew that JACK RUBY was an occasional customer of this station and after the assassination of President KENNEDY on November 22, 1963, and the murder of LEE HARVEY OSWALD on November 24, 1963, it was common discussion among all employees at the service station that RUBY had been a customer there and some of the employees knew RUBY's roommate, GEORGE SENATOR, still buys gasoline from the station on occasion.

He said that he had never known LEE HARVEY OSWALD or anything about him until after the two aforementioned incidents, and then it was determined that RUBY and OSWALD had both lived in an area which was not very far from this filling station. He said he had no recollection of waiting on a customer from Minnesota on December 22, 1963, but many out-of-town customers had made inquiry concerning the location of the assassination site, which may be readily viewed from the service station, which is located about a mile or so south of the Texas School Book Depository Building in Dallas, Texas.

He said that he recalled that he worked from 6:00 AM to 4:00 PM on December 23, 1963, and JAMES SYMON was the other employee who worked at the station from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM on that date, together with Mr. TOM MULLINE, the manager of the station. Mr. LEWIS said that he did not know JACK RUBY as a personal friend and knew of no relationship or association between RUBY and OSWALD, and he did not recall that OSWALD had ever been a patron of the service station. He said he had never patronized the Carousel Club or Vegas Club when they were operated by JACK RUBY in Dallas.
