Detective R. L. STUDEBAKER, Crime Scene Search Section, Identification Bureau, Dallas Police Department, on November 22, 1963, advised that he and his partner had made detailed photo-graphs of the sixth floor of the Texas School Book Depository Building, Elm and Houston streets, Dallas, had measured the floor, and made a drawing of it, had conducted a thorough crime scene search of the floor and had dusted everything in the area of the southwest corner of the floor in an effort to develop latent finger or palm prints. He stated that he had been successful in locating a latent print on the wrapping paper on a bundle of books or school supplies on which the assassin of President KENNEDY had apparently sat while shooting at KENNEDY. He stated that he had found what appeared to be brown wrapping paper and tape in which a rifle had been wrapped for concealment and was present when a rifle was found on the sixth floor of the Texas School Book Depository Building.

STUDEBAKER advised copies of the photographs and drawings would be made available to the FBI if desired.
