Lieutenant J. CARL DAY, Identification Division, Dallas, Texas, Police Department, advised he obtained a sample of Kraft wrapping paper and 3" paper tape from the rolls of Kraft paper mounted in the shipping room on the main floor of the Texas School Book Depository, 411 Elm Street, Dallas, on November 22, 1963.

DAY advised these samples were obtained for possible future comparison and that these samples were obtained under the supervision of Mr. ROY S. TRULY, Warehouse Manager of the Texas School Book Depository, and were subsequently released to the custody of SA VINCENT E. DRAIN, of the Dallas FBI Office, for transmittal to the FBI Laboratory.

DAY advised that on November 22, 1963, he was told by Mr. TRULY that these rolls were the only opened rolls in the entire building utilized for wrapping purposes, and that all of these rolls had come from a complete shipment from one paper supplier previously purchased several months prior to that time.
