Detective JOHN P. ADAMCIX, Dallas Police Department, advised that he had participated in a search of the PAINE residence, 2515 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas, on November 22 and 23, 1963. He recalled seeing some cameras at the residence but believed they belonged to Mrs. PAINE and believed they had been picked up and brought in to the Dallas Police Station. During the search Mrs. PAINE pointed out what belonged to OSWALD and what belonged to her. He recalled that most of the property in the garage belonged to OSWALD and most of his property was brought in, particularly anything they believed to be of any evidentiary value.

Detective ADAMCIX was shown FBI laboratory photograph D-146 of an Imperial Reflex camera which had been obtained from ROBERT OSWALD, Denton, Texas, on February 24, 1964. He stated that he could not recall ever seeing this camera and that he did not recall seeing any cameras during a search of the garage at the PAINE residence. He added, "If we had seen a camera among his belongings we would have certainly brought it in."
