Detective GUY F. ROSE, Dallas Police Department, advised that he had participated in a search of the PAINE residence, 2515 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas, on November 22 and 23, 1963. He recalled obtaining from the house some cameras and some camera equipment which Mrs. PAINE identified as belonging to her. He stated that the search on November 23, 1963, was concentrated on the garage where most of OSWALD's belongings were located. He recalled seeing some books in a box, but no cameras.

Detective ROSE was shown FBI Laboratory photograph D-146 of an Imperial Reflex camera which had been obtained from ROBERT OSWALD, Denton, Texas, on February 24, 1964. He stated that he definitely has never seen this camera and added that if it had been discovered during the search they would have brought it in.
