Miss FRANCES BIANCON, 6619 Ascot Lane, telephone EM 8-7943, who is employed as a Bookkeeper at the North Haven Gardens, 7700 Northaven Road, Dallas, Texas, telephone EM 3-5316, telephonically advised she had been sorting out some old magazines at her residence and came upon Time Magazine issue of June 21, 1963, which bore the address label, "LEE H. OSWALD, Box 2915, Dallas 21, Texas."

Miss BIANCON stated this issue of Time Magazine contained a photograph of President KENNEDY and Attorney General ROBERT KENNEDY.

Miss BIANCON stated she had received this Time Magazine sometime in approximately the latter part of June, 1963, from GONZALO ANCIRA, with whom she was working at the time at the Wade Corporation, Hartford Building, Dallas, Texas. She stated GONZALO ANCIRA is an Engineer for the Wade Corporation and resides at 1803 Cooper, Irving, Texas, telephone Blackburn 3-2965. She stated ANCIRA has made frequent travels to Mexico and that on the day of the assassination of President KENNEDY she asked ANCIRA if he was going to watch the Presidential motorcade, to which ANCIRA replied, "He's not my President," or words to that effect. She stated that, for approximately two weeks immediately after the assassination, ANCIRA disappeared from Dallas for reasons unknown to her.

Miss BIANCON stated she did not know if ANCIRA was acquainted with LEE HARVEY OSWALD, but that he did give her the Time Magazine, which she now has in her possession, bearing the address label of LEE H. OSWALD.

At the time Miss BIANCON contacted the Dallas Office she, at first, refused to divulge her name, stating she did not want to become involved.
