Kane to Do Play About Lee Oswald

OXFORD, England, Aug. 20
A theater company here has
commissioned American law-
yer and Warren report critic
Mark Lane to write a play
depicting Lee Harvey Oswald
on trial.

It will aim to show that on
the Warren Commission's
evidence Oswald stood a good
chance of getting off any
charges of killing President
Kennedy, a theater spokesman
said today.

Lane is expected to bring
the script when he visits
England next month for the
first publication of his book
"Rush to Judgment," a criti-
cism of the assassination in-
vestigation.

Frank Hauser, a director of
the Oxford Playhouse Theater,
said the two-part play would
set out available prosecution
evidence and the defense that
could be raised against it.

The court scenes would not
be realistic, he said. All roles
apart from the lawyers would
probably be played by a small
cast of actors changing hats
and coats.

The play would probably
give no verdict and Oswald
himself would not appear, he
added.

The prosecution case would
be entirely from the Warren
Commission report, with tape
recordings and film excerpts.
The defense would dramatize
the confusion and contradic-
tion a lawyer might have
brought up on Oswald's be-
half, Hauser said.
