

Kennedys Are Satisfied On Murder Findings

SAN ANTONIO, Tex., Feb. 22 (UPI)—Eunice Kennedy Shriver says the Kennedy family is satisfied with the results of the investigations into the assassination of John F. and Robert F. Kennedy and sees no reason for any further inquiries. Mrs. Shriver, wife of Sargent Shriver, the 1972 Vice-Presidential candidate commented yesterday on a resolution introduced in Congress calling for new investigations into the murders of her two brothers.

"As a member of my family, we are perfectly satisfied with the Warren Commission report," she said. The commission decided that Lee Harvey Oswald, acting alone, assassinated President Kennedy.
