

**Cuban Exile Groups Plan  
Wide Sabotage Campaign**

Leaders of Cuban exile groups in the United States said yesterday that they would wage a sabotage campaign against the regime of Premier Fidel Castro and "any other nation which supports Castro."

Ignacio Novo, a coordinator of the exiles' movement, said the campaign would include "blowing up Russian ships in international waters or any ship of any nation who helps the Castro regime."

He said that the exiles would work "outside of the United States" in order not to involve the United States.

The campaign was announced at a meeting of 500 exiles belonging to seven major exile groups at the Palm Gardens, 310 West 52d Street.

Indictments against Mr. Novo, his brother Guillermo and Julio Perez in the bazooka-shelling of the United Nations Building in December, 1964, were dismissed in 1965 after the defendants' confessions were ruled inadmissible.
