CIA Probe Needed, Gerstein Says

The facts developed by New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison in investigating the Kennedy assassination should cause a congressional inquiry of the Central Intelligence Agency, State Attorney Richard E. Gerstein said Monday.

"I don't know if he (Garrison) is right or wrong; that will be proven in court," said Gerstein, who lent Garrison the resources of his staff while the New Orleans prosecutor was probing a possible Miami aspect of the case. "But an inquiry should be made by Congress into activities of the CIA in connection with the assassination," Gerstein said in a radio interview.
