A prominent college professor has developed a shocking theory with significant documentation that links Richard M. Nixon, disgraced ex-chief executive, with persons involved in the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Trowbridge Ford, 44-year-old political scientist from Holy Cross and former member of the U.S. Army's Counterintelligence Corps, turned his information over to John Doar, the special counsel to the House Judiciary Committee, which voted articles of impeachment against Nixon. When contacted, Doar refused to discuss Ford's charges.

Part of Ford's documentation is the revelation that Nixon, acting as a member of the House Committee on Un-American Activities in 1947, balled Jack Ruby out of a jam with the committee.

Ruby, of course, murdered Lee Harvey Oswald before millions of television viewers in the basement of the Dallas City office building, just two days after Oswald supposedly assassinated Kennedy.

A DAILLAS STRIP joint operator, Ruby previously lived in Chicago and went by the name Jack Rubenstein.

An FBI memo obtained by TATTLER indicates that Ruby was to be called as a witness before the Un-American Activities Committee until then-Congressman Nixon interceded.
