Slain Kennedys Called 'Most Dangerous Men'

DALLAS, Jan. 28 (AP)—John and Robert Kennedy were two of the most dangerous men America ever produced, William M. Kunstler, the radical lawyer, said yesterday, adding that he was "not entirely upset" by their assassination.

"Although I couldn't pull the trigger myself, I don't disagree with murder sometimes, especially political assassinations, which have been a part of political life since the beginning of recorded history," Mr. Kunstler told a news conference.

"I'm not entirely upset by the Kennedy assassinations," Mr. Kunstler added. "In many ways two of the most dangerous men in the country were eliminated."

Mr. Kunstler, who was here to address a political seminar at Southern Methodist University, was the defense counsel for the Chicago 7 group, charged with disrupting the Democratic National Convention in 1968. He also is chief counsel for William and Emily Harris, both members of the self-styled Symbionese Liberation Army.
