The Warren Commission was correct in assigning to Lee Harvey Oswald sole responsibility for the assassination of President Kennedy, said Malcolm M. Kilduff, the only White House press aide who witnessed the crime. In a radio-TV interview on the eve of the third anniversary of the assassination, Kilduff also said there was friction between the Kennedy and Johnson factions aboard the funeral plane flying back to Washington. He gave no details.
