The assassinations committee, formed in September to investigate the mur-ders of John F. Rennedy and Dr. Martin Luider King Jr., officially went out of business on the first day of the new session last week when a lone member objected to its extension.

Temerrow a resolution requiring a two-thirds vote of approval will seek House permission for confirmed operation of the assassination committee with a budget of approximately \$10,000 a month while the House Administration Committee ponders the long-range financing request.
