Assassin Probe Revival Moves NASHINGTON (UPI) - The House Rules Committee today voted to resurrect a panel to investigate the murders of John Kennedy and Martin Luther King Jr., but imposed a tight budget and said it has two months to justify its existence. By voice vote, the committee passed a resolution to reconstitute the 12member committee and said the assassination paney has until March 31 to set its rules before seeking additional funds. Originally created by the last Congress for a "final" pribe of assassinations of Kennedy and King, the panel expired Jan. 3 with the last session.
