Mr. LEONARD CALVERLEY, foreman, Camera Department, Jaggars - Chiles - Stovall, Inc., 522 Browder, advised that he was the immediate supervisor of LEE HARVEY OSWALD during the time OSWALD was employed by that company. Mr. CALVERLEY was shown a photograph of the leather sling used as a rifle sling on the rifle used in the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, although he was not told the use of this object. Mr. CALVERLEY said that he had never seen such an article in OSWALD's possession, and that this article was not any property of Jaggars - Chiles - Stovall, Inc.; however, he believed that this article looked like a camera case strap.
