2 Polygraph Experts Urge Lie Detector Test for Ruby

DALLAS, Dec. 25 (UPI)—
Two polygraph experts think
Jack Ruby should be given a
lie detector test "in the interest
of history."

Several Texas authorities
contend it is too late for a
valid test because of the wide-
spread cancer in Ruby, the
slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald,
who killed President Kennedy.

Chris Gugas, Los Angeles
polygraph expert, said yester-
day that some agency other
than the Texas Department of
Public Safety should give the
test. He and Cleve Baxter of
New York sent a telegram to
the Texas Attorney General,
Waggoner Carr, asking that
they be allowed to give the
test.

Ruby requested a test to
prove he was not involved in
a conspiracy in the slaying of
President Kennedy.

"It is too late" to give the
test, according to Andrew L.
Smith, head of Truth Verifica-
tion, Inc., in Dallas. He said
polygraphs measured the re-
sponse of tissue, and "when you
take drugs to kill cancer, you
also kill the normal tissue."
