Ruby Requests Stay of Hearing

Counsel for Jack Ruby filed a request in the Supreme Court yesterday for a stay of a sanity hearing scheduled for June 13 in Criminal Court in Dallas, Tex.

Ruby was convicted as the slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald, identified by the Warren Commission as the assassin of President Kennedy. Ruby was given the death penalty.

The request also asked for a stay of all state court appeal proceedings pending the filing of an appeal to the Supreme Court.
