Justice Black Refuses To Stay Ruby Hearing

WASHINGTON, June 3—(AP)—Justice Hugo L. Black of the Supreme Court refused Friday to stay a sanity hearing for Jack Ruby, convicted of killing Lee Harvey Oswald, named by the Warren Commission as the assassin of President John F. Kennedy.

The hearing is scheduled for June 13 in criminal court in Dallas, Texas. Ruby is under sentence to death.

Black issued a brief order of denial in which he said:

"I do not feel justified in granting a stay which will interfere with the orderly and customary processes of the courts of Texas in attempts to give Ruby a fair and prompt determination of his rights."
