## Sanity Hearing For Ruby Upheld

WASHINGTON (AP). — Justice Hugo L. Black of the Supreme Court refused Friday to stay a sanity hearing for Jack Ruby, convicted of killing Lee Harvey Oswald, named by the Warren Commission as the assassin of President John F. Kennedy.

The hearing is scheduled for June 13 in Criminal Court in Dallas, Texas. Ruby is under sentence of death.

The New York attorney for Ruby had asked that the sanity hearing be deferred until a formal appeal in the Ruby case is filed later in the Supreme Court.
