## March 17, 1967

A second witness at the preliminary hearing, Vernon Bundy, testified that he had seen Clay Shaw in the company of Lee Harvey Oswald at a lake in the New Orleans area in the summer of 1963. In another action, attorney Dean Adams Andrews, Jr., was arrested after a grand jury indicted him for MANNAMMANN perjury.

## March 18, 1967

Clay Shaw was ordered to stand trial by the judges at the preliminary hearing.

## March 23, 1967

The New Orleans grand jury issued an indictment against Clay Shaw for conspiracy to assassinate President Kennedy.

## April 5, 1967

Clay Shaw entered a plea of not guilty. Layton Martens, a former roommate of David Ferrie, was indicted on a charge of perjury by the grand jury.
