Dear Mr. Olson,

I am sorry to say that there is no copy of the Subject Index to be had, from any source, and I am therefore returning your check.

Several people have written to me at various times since the Subject Index went out of print, and I have advised them to locate and xerox a library copy. Should you be able to do so, this letter will authorize you to make not more than two copies, for non-commercial use. If you decide to follow this course, please let me know and I will send you some Errata sheets.

It is probably superfluous to say this, but just to be on the side of safety I should emphasize that the Subject Index is useful only if you have the 26-volume Hearings and Exhibits.

If you are not able to locate a library copy of the Subject Index, I would be willing to lend you for one week a microfilm of the Index, from which you could have the pages printed. I am reluctant to risk damage or loss of the microfilm, as you will understand, so please consider that only as a last resort. If you decide to borrow the microfilm, please send a supply of stamps to cover mailing.
