Mr. JAMES UNDERWOOD, newsmen, KP1D-TV, Dallas, advised that he had taken 16 millimeter movie films in the area of the Texas School Book Depository Building at 411 Elm Street, on November 22, 1963, immediately after the assassination of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY.

He advised that during the time that he was in the area on November 22, 1963, a Deputy Sheriff whom he does not recall had pointed out a mark on the curbing on the south side of Main Street near the triple underpass. UNDERWOOD stated that the mark was fresh and, in his opinion, it could have been caused by a bullet striking the curb. He stated that the cement was not broken; however, the object that struck the curb had hit it with such force that it left a fresh white mark.

UNDERWOOD related that on Saturday, November 23, 1963, he was assigned to stand by at the Dallas County Jail to cover the possible transfer of LEE HARVEY OSWALD from the Dallas Police Department Jail to the County Jail. He advised that after remaining near the jail entrance for a length of time, he decided to walk down to the triple underpass and take movie film of the mark. He advised that to the best of his recollection, the mark must have been approximately twenty to twenty-five feet from the point where Main Street passed under the triple underpass and was on the south side of the street. He stated that he was not positive that it was a bullet mark, but decided to film the mark in the event, at a later date, it became pertinent or proved to be caused by a bullet striking the curb.

UNDERWOOD made available a photograph of a frame from the 16 millimeter movie film depicting the mark, and also made available a photograph of a frame from the 16 millimeter movie film taken from the mark on the curb which could be used as a reference point. UNDERWOOD stated that in taking the film with the Texas School Book Depository Building in the background, he had used a wide angle lens.
