Dr. RICHARD A. LIGUORI, 4125 Swiss Avenue, telephone Taylor 3-4682, advised he is on the house staff of Methodist Hospital of Dallas, 301 West Colorado, telephone WH 6-8181, and is the physician who pronounced dead J. D. TIPPIT. He was pronounced dead at 1:25 p.m., keepabor 22, 1963, and an examination of the body indicated him death could be attributed to gunshot wounds. There appeared three wounds in the hody, one being in the right temple which in the opinion of Dr. LIGUORI could have caused instant death, one wound in the left chest, the bullet being deflected by a brass button of the uniform worn by Officer TIPPIT and the bullet being found only about one inch under the surface, and the third wound in the upper abdomen.
