On March 30, 1964, Lt. CARL PAY, Dallas Police Department Crime Laboratory, Dallas, Texas, advised Special Agent VINCENT E. J. DRAIN that the Dallas Police Department Crime Laboratory had turned over all of the .38 calibre bullets and cartridge cases that had been recovered in connection with the shooting of Officer J. D. RIPPIT by LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He stated that as far as he knew and the records of the Dallas Police Department reflect, the Federal Bureau of Investigation is in possession of all of the recovered cartridge cases and bullets. He stated that it is very possible that a bullet or cartridge case for OSWALD's revolver may not have been found as such bullets and casings were found by individuals in the area and turned in to the Dallas Police Department.
