BOUHE formerly worked as a bookkeeper with Degalyer-MacCaughton Oil Consultants, 5625 Daniels Street, Dallas. BISHOP stated W. A. KOPPEAK, Dagube Oil Company, 12th floor, United Fidelity Building, is a long-time working acquaintance of BOUHE. He advised BOUHE is very highly emotional.
