de vas positive that after he had observed this ratite the window, he sim this person take "deliberate ain" and fire a $\therefore$ at. He then observed this person take the rile from ins shoulder an Hold it by the barrel of the rifle, as it he were resting the butt of the File on the floor. Be said this individual observed the scene on the street below momentarily, and then stepped back from the window. Fe sad the rifle was pointed in the direction of the Presidents car when he sam it fixed.

EN advised there was nothing to obstruct his lime of vision between the place where he was seated and the window on the cloth floor of the Texas School book Depository building where he saw the ran with the rifle. Eve estimated distance between the point where he was seated and the window from which the shots were fired to be approximately 90 yards.

He noticed there appeared to be a stack of heavy cartons Visible in the window and slightly to the rear of the place where the man stood with the rifle. He stated he saw two Negro men on the next lower floor, immediately beneath the window where theron was observed with the rifle.
