Mr. HARRY HOLMES, Inspector, U. S. Post Office, Terminal Annex, Dallas, advised he and several employees in his office were watching the Presidential Motorcade on the afternoon of November 22, 1963 at the time of the President's assassination. Mr. HOLMES pointed out the windows of his office looked down on the area in which the fatal shots were fired. Mr. HOLMES said he was using a pair of binoculars himself at the time of the shooting, and one of the employees in his office was observing the Fresident when the bullets struck the President.
