Nr. ROYCE CREN STAEMON, 2509 Reagan, Dub. 105. Balsas. texas, was interuseved at his place of employments the Texas-Loulstena Present Bureau, Rom 215. Union Texminch Building, and fumbshed the following information:

Mr. SKETHON advised that he and a fellow workers AUSTEI LAWRENGE ITKMER, decided to watch the Erestdexthat Motorcade on November 22, 2963 from the railroad tracks on top ot the triple rallioad overpass on the Elm Street side pacing east. They aped at this spot about Iz:35 P. M. and watioce until the Erestantial motorcade came by.

Ms. SEGMON noticed that as an open itmoushme bumped on Elm Street, ht had moved approximately one hundred feet at which time he noticed dust spray up from the street in front of the can on the drivers ste. miss dust speed came from the direction of the Texas school Book Depository bundurs. A few seconds later he heard what he believed to be three shots. He die not see anyone fall but he saw a woman grab someone ard hold hum and heard her say "On, no! On, rot!" It seemed es ff the car slowed down for a few seconds and thou he heard a vole say something to the effect of: "Get out or heme, ${ }^{2 r}$ ard tho car quiciry sped away.

Immediacy theneafters he fumed around trying to lodi sn all directions at once, and watched newsmen runtime around frying to take pletures. He also noticed a motoreyche lying in the street. He does not recall seeing anyone case that be knew on the railroad overpass of un the vicinity of the shooting besides Mr. INTEEE, and a man he believes was the electrician of the Union Hemal Building out who ge name ne does not recons.

He does not recall ever seeing the Frestaent of the Un ted states during the above-described scene.
