The following investigation was conducted by Special Agents RAY A. PINKSTON and GEORGE W. H. CARLSON:

SARAH STANTON, 227 North Ewing, Apartment A-4, on November 23, 1963, advised that she is employed in the second floor office of the Texas School Book Depository, 411 Elm Street, Dallas, Texas, and at about 12:30 P. M., on November 22, 1963, she was standing on the front steps of the building as the President passed and shortly thereafter she heard three explosions; however, she did not know where they came from and immediately went into the building, caught the elevator and went to the second floor offices and into the office of the Southwestern Publishing Company, located there, to try to look out the window and see what was happening. She then went to the restroom and later returned to her desk. She knows LEE HARVEY OSWALD by sight, being employed by the same concern, but is not personally acquainted with him and did not see OSWALD on November 22, 1963, and has never seen him with a gun.
