She resides at 5946 Ellsworth, Dallas. Her husband. ts employed by the Southeresem Bell Pelechone Company. Mrs. PARKER on November $22,1953$. Jet the offices or the Gregg Publishing Company and waked across the street to a small park from which vantage point she observed the Presidential Motorcade. With her at the time were DELORES KOHNAS and ILOYDR, VIES, azo employees of the Gregg Publishing company She noted that 412 En Street 3 s the address for the Texas School Book Depository bustard. The car in which President KENNEDY, Governor GONAGTY ad their wives were mong hod. passed Mrs PAPGRR or by a shat de stance when she heard what she thought was a shatwom her location, she was unable to see whether the shot had hit anyone in the Presidential car. The shot sounded to her as though it had come from a cement memorial buidijng to the north of the Texas School Book Depository on Em Street She looked in that direction but saw nothing that she oud rotate to the shot. During that. the, she heard two addttorin shots and in looking around glanced at the Texas School Book Depository building which was directly arose Em from her. She noted that a number of whins were per ce the fifth and sixth floors of the building, but son bo one stardirg in any cr those windows.

On seeing the photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWATJ in the newspapers she believed she rocsorized him as an individual she had seen on one ccoaston in the lunch room at the bujading She did not talk to him at the time and noted that he was by himself on that occasion she res had no contact with OSWADD and does not brow bim.

She advised that she has seen photographs in the news media of TAOK RUBY but to hen knowledge has never seen him and knows of no correction he might have with OSWADD.


Mrs. UAMES Y. (DOROTHY) LOVELADY, was Interviewed a the Southwestern Publishing Company, 421 Elm, Dallas, where she is employed. She resides 34277 Fairbrook, Irving, Tex telephone EI: 5-4261. Mrs: IOVEIADY advised that she was sick and therefore rot at work on November 22, 1963, and had no information regarding the assassination of former President JOHN $F$. KENNEDY. UpOn seeing the photograph of IEE HARVE OSWALD in the local newspapers and on television, she recognt: him as a person whom she hat seen at the lunchroom in the building on one or possibly two occasions. She did not know him by name until he was identified to her through the news media, and had never had any coact with him. She advised t? she did not know JACK RUBY End to her know edge he had never. been at the Texas Soho Book Depository on in touch with OSWALD.

MrS. JOSPPH A. (VTCKX) DAVIS, 684 Southeast 8th Street, Grand Prairie, Texas, telephone AN. 2-012T, was interviewed at the Southwestern Publishing Company, 41 Elm, Dallas, or December .25, 2963. Mas JAVIS advised that she is an employee of the southwestern publishing Company but was not at work on November 2 ? 2563 since she was sick that day She had no information oonerning the assassination of TOEA $F$. KENNDDY, With reference to TEE HARVEY OSMITD, she advised that after seeing his photograph on television and in the newspapers, she recegnazd him as a person whom she had seen on several occasions in the Texas School Book Depository Building tit Elm. Whit she saw his name in the papers. she did not know his ane and never had any convetsam tron with him. She had wo information concerning oubato. She acivised that TAGK RUBY was unkrom to her and to her knowledge she had never seers him at 411 Elm Dallas.
