"Accessories After the Fact," by Sylvia Meagher. (Bobbs-Merrill: \$8.50. pp.) Sylvia Meagher's reasoned attack on the Warren

Commission's hearings and report is much more convincing than any of the books written by screamers and theorists. It is hardly possible to read it and retain surety that Oswald was the man who assassinated the President. Miss Meagher is devastating in her presentation of some of the evidence. Her main point is that the testimony should be re-taken using the American adversary system so that points that were ignored or glossed over could be dealt with fully.
